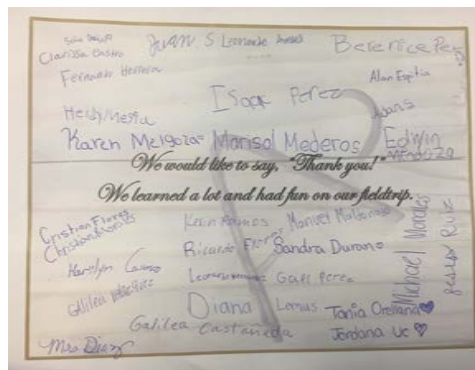
Mission "I didn't know the Native Americans used mud to make tiles and that animals would step on them. And that they left marks on the church tiles." Galilea V.
